From the solemn prelude God hath, in these last days, spoken unto us in His Son (Ch. i: i, 2), to the exultant finale, for yet a little while--how little! how little! and He that shall come will come and will not tarry (Ch. x: 37), the same motif constantly recurs. Of the 303 verses into which the epistle is divided, thirtysix, or nearly one verse in every eight, has reference to the second coming of our Lord, or to events that are closely related to his re-appearing; while the proportion of such verses in the entire...
