Excerpt: .a few one-seeded pistils, becoming small drupes in fruit, with a moon-shaped or kidney-shaped stone. We have two genera of one species each, the first common at the North, the second at the South. 1. Stamens 12 to 20: pistils 2 to 4.

Flowers white: leaves rounded and angled shield-shaped. Fruit blue-black, (Menispermum) Moonseed. 2. Stamens 6, one before each petal. Flowers greenish: leaves heart-shaped.

(Coccitulus) Coccus. 6. BARBERRY FAMILY. Order

BEEBEEIDACEE. Readily distinguished (with a single exception) by having the sepals and petals in fours, fives, or eights (not in fives), and with just the same number of stamens as petals, one before each petal (on the receptacle), the anthers opening by an uplifted valve or door on each side. Pistil only one Harmless, except the May-Apple (also called Mandrake), which has rather poisonous roots, although the fruit is innocent and eatable.
